**RESOLUTION NO. 51-2023**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE UTILIZATION OF THE ER 1-94 FUNDS WITH JOBIN SQM INC. (JSI) PURSUANT TO DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY CIRCULAR NO. 2018-08-0021**

**WHEREAS**, Section 5(i) of Republic Act No. 7638, otherwise known as the "Department of Energy Act of 1992" mandates that the Department of Energy (DOE) to devise way and means of giving direct benefits to the province, city or municipality, especially the community and people affected and equitable and preferential benefit to the region that hosts the energy resource and/or the energy-generating facility;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant thereto, Energy Regulations No. 1-94 ("ER 1-94") was issued by DOE to operationalize the implementation of Section 5(i) of RA 7638 by granting financial benefits to communities hosting energy generating facilities and/or energy resource developers;

**WHEREAS**, Section 66 of Republic Act No. 9136, otherwise known as the "Electric Power Industry Reform Act of 2002" or EPIRA and Rules 29(A) of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (EPIRA-IRR) require Generation Companies (GenCos) and/or Energy Resource Developers (ERDs) to provide financial benefits equivalent to one centavo per kilowatt-hour (Php 0.01/kWh) of the total electricity sales of the generation facility to the region, province, city or municipality and barangay that hosts the generation facility and

energy resource facility, as well as the establishment of corresponding trust accounts and the administration thereof by the DOE;

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Republic Act No. 8371, otherwise known as the "Indigenous Peoples Rights Act of 1997", the DOE issued Department Circular No. DC2018-03-0005, which recognizes the rights of the Indigenous Cultural Communities and Indigenous Peoples to their ancestral domain and the natural resources therein and provide for reasonable share in the development and livelihood fund DLG and for the Reforestation, Watershed Management, Health and/or Environment Enhancement Fund (RWMHEEF) components of the ER 1-94 funds;

**WHEREAS**, the DOE also issued Department Circular No. DC2018-08-0021, which amended Rule 29(A) of the EPIRA-IRR, to accelerate socio-economic development and to have a more effective and efficient utilization of the funds and to enforce the immediate provision of benefits to Host communities;

**WHEREAS**, JSI is a GenCo which operates the 100 Megawatt-peak Sta. Rita Solar Power Project under a Solar Energy Service Contract with the DOE;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Government of Hermosa (MGH) is one of the designated beneficiaries of the 100 Megawatt-peak Sta. Rita Solar Power Project and related facilities to which the DOE had been remitting a share in the Development and Livelihood Fund ("DLF") and the RWMHEEF pursuant to Rule 29(A) of the EPIRA-IRR;

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Work Program to be submitted by the MGH is in accordance with the current Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Comprehensive Development Plan;

**WHEREAS**, the MGH has prepared the Annual Work Plan which is herein attached herewith as Annex A and therefore forms an integral part of this Resolution;

**WHEREAS**, this council, after careful thought and thorough consideration of the benefits to be derived from the utilization of the ER 1-94 funds with JSI, finds that the authority requested by the municipal mayor is just and proper under the circumstances;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Councilor Floyd J. Tungol, duly seconded and approved by all the members present, be it:

**RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, to approve the utilization of the ER 1-94 funds with JSI pursuant to Department of Energy Circular No. 2018-08-0021;
